Benefits

Navigator Reporting is an ad hoc report writer that enables you to extract data from the Navigator Suite common database and create and modify reports on the fly. This add-on module allows you to create greater visibility into the operational processes that all Navigator Suite applications support.

- **Curriculum Management Process** – Navigator Reporting can create areas of visibility throughout this process at a micro to macro level. Here are a few examples. Extract how many new courses were approved during an academic year, what goal areas they meet, how many programs were reviewed, were they approved. Produce monthly and annual reports that lists out what was approved, relegated, denied during our curriculum process.
- **Academic Progress** – Are students taking much longer than expected to graduate? Navigator Reporting highlights the percentage completion of each student within any pre-defined group and flags outliers in the data for advising follow-up. Use our existing reports to highlight the remaining credits needed per student and our pie-charting capability to depict the deficient course areas. What's more, frequently unmet, waived or modified degree or program requirements can be flagged for academic (curriculum) review.
- **Graduation** – Want to know who can be certified for graduation within any degree or program? Navigator Reporting can flag both the positives and the negatives for graduation potential.
- **Academic Planning** – Need advanced knowledge to plan how many new sections must to be added for a given course? Navigator Reporting can give the user a roll-up of the remaining coursework that needs to be achieved over a finite timeframe (e.g. time to graduation) and flags these courses for planning and scheduling consideration.
- **Government-Mandated** – Are students taking too long to complete studies tied to financial aid? Need to justify your financial aid budgeting to state-wide or federal bodies? Navigator Reporting can flag students that have exceeded the maximum timeframe for financially assisted study. It can also demonstrate numbers for minimum enrollment criteria tied to financial aid budgeting and accountability.
- **Marketing and Recruiting** – Want to know where your students are coming from based on transfer articulation data? Navigator Reporting lets you fine-tune your new enrollment efforts to specific locales by letting you know where your students are coming from and also where they are not.

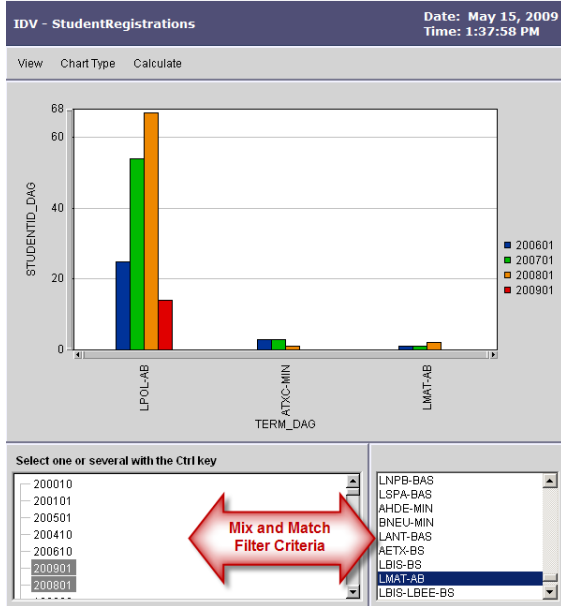
